What is Rotary Friendship Exchange?

- An international exchange program between two Districts for Rotarians and Rotary couples.
- An opportunity to experience other cultures by staying in the homes of Rotarians, visiting club activities, and participating in the life style/activities of their communities. Cost of basic airfare is picked up by each member of the team. Costs within the Districts visited can be minimal and are negotiated between Districts in advance. Our district generally picks up most of the District events and travelling costs with the help of local clubs and hosts.

- To advance international understanding and peace through visits across borders.
- To promote inter-club relationships, fellowships and service projects.
- The Rotarians participating gain the opportunity to make long lasting friendships

- Offering a room in your home for **2 nights - May 16 and 17th** and some meals (usually breakfasts) and maybe other meals, depending on club plans
- A curiosity and openness to sharing yourself and learning about the lives of Rotarians visiting us.
