Giving Helps Lives



Reaching Our Goals

Assets of the Foundation reached \$1,524,990 for 2017, an increase of over \$109,000 from the prior year. This increase was made possible because of a combination of \$96,150 in contributions plus investment returns of \$82,250. This gave us the ability to provide \$58,700 in scholarships and community grants.





Our Future Depends on Your Help

The Board has a set of continuing goals established five years ago and remain relevant today.

- Improving the effectiveness of the Foundations donor outreach program
- Developing and implementing an effective marketing plan
- Strengthening the working relationship between the Club and the Foundation
- Increasing the level of contributions from Club members as well as non-club members.

The Board has short term goals aimed at improving the operation of the Foundation. Examples of these goals are updating the Bylaws and Trustee Handbook, review of the investment Policy, develop and implement a marketing plan, enhance communication through the use of technology, and improve tracking system for grant and scholarship recipients.

The Foundation also supports the Rotary Club's charitable giving programs such as the Giro Bello and Joint Charitable Projects Committee. Another reason for the financial success of the Foundation is ultra-low **annual expenses of 9/10 of one percent** of our assets for 2017! This comes from volunteer help; and generous outreach by local groups including the Rotary Club of Santa Rosa who created the Foundation.
