

## Rotary Scholarship Program

## Applications Open January 6, 2025 and Close March 1, 2025

The Rotary Club of Santa Rosa Foundation (RCSRF) is offering 14 scholarships for both continuing and transfer students currently attending Santa Rosa Junior College (SRJC). To be eligible to apply SRJC students must have a minimum grade point average of 3.0 and plan to enroll as full-time students (12 units or more) in Fall 2025.

Some of the scholarships require the applicant to be in a specific major such as Business, Health Science or Engineering while others are open to any major. There is also a scholarship designated for military veterans and another for a student with a verifiable disability. The value of the scholarships range in amount from \$2,000 to \$5,000 and some are renewable for a second year.

## **Eligibility To Apply:**

- 1. Be currently enrolled at SRJC with the exception of the military veterans scholarships.
- 2. Have a minimum GPA of 3.0 for all college coursework.
- 3. Plan to enroll full time as a transfer or continuing student in Fall 2025.
- 4. Completed at least one semester at SRJC by June 2025 unless a SSU military veteran.

## **Application Procedure (Two Options) & Deadline:**
